Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia & his Successors in Office, that is to say the said Jacob Senow in the sum of five hundred dollars and the said Willis M. Lawrence & Nelson B. Gardner in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars each of their respective goods & chattels lands & Tenements to be lawfull, and to the said Governor & his Successors in Office to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Jacob Senow shall make his personal appearance before the Justice of the Quarter Court of Southampton at the next Term thereof on the first day of the next Term of the said Court, then and then to abide such order as shall be made against him the said Jacob Senow of and concerning the felony wherof he stands charged in forging a bond against Joseph Senow, James Senow & Francis Senow, and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

Francis Sonen John M. Holland & Henrietta Holland who have been summoned to appear here this day as witnesses in behalf of the Commonwealth against Jacob Senow, were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is ordered that they be summoned to appear here at the next Term of this Court to show cause if any they can why they should not be bound for their said contempt?
