

William L. Orritt who hath been Commissioned Sheriff of this County by a Commission from the Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor with the seal of the Commonwealth annexed bearing date the 29th day of November 1842. This day appeared in Court and together with Edwards & Route William L. Schell Robert Ricks Nicholas M. Schell (and Clements Roschell his securities entered into three several bonds in the penalty of \$30,000 each conditioned according to law, which bonds were acknowledged by the obligors therein named & ordered to be recorded. And the said William L. Orritt took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth, the oath against duelling, the oath to support the Constitution of the United States and the oath of Office.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Fols Bridge this day made their report in the following words to wit: "Agreeable to the above order from the worshipful Court of Southampton we the undersigned have let the repairs of Fols Bridge among the three bidders as above directed, and Henry Pittaway became the undertaker for the sum of nine Dollars, and we do further report that the same is done according to Contract. Given under our hands this 21st day of December 1842. "Benjⁿ Applewhite, Thomas Wrenn."

The Commissioners appointed to let the altering of the Road on the South side of the Notting way near Jerusalem this day made the following report to wit: "The Commissioners appointed to let and receive the road nearly Jerusalem by have to report that the road was completed according to the terms agreed upon by the commissioners, and after an examination was duly received which is respectfully submitted to the Court. G. A. M. Neuron J. H. Schell A. M. Schell M. D. Goodwyn Comm^s Whereupon the Court doth establish the new road as a public highway & order that the old road be discontinued.

On the motion of Sefu Sanford against Alfred Ricks guardian to John Patton & Mary Patton orphans of Joseph Patton dec^d for Oventer do anty. This day came the parties in their proper person who being heard it is ordered that the said Alfred Ricks give the said Sefu Sanford good counter security, the bond for which purpose is to be in the penalty of \$25,000 and conditioned as the law directs. Whereupon the said Alfred Ricks together with J. D. Wapondway Elm. Probst & Benjⁿ Rowanby his securities entered into & acknowledged a bond according to the above order.

The Court doth assign William Edwards guardian to Louisa Vaughan orphan of Anthony Vaughan and thereupon the said William Edwards together with William V. Edwards and Oran Vaughan his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand five hundred Dollars conditioned according to law.
