

William L. Everett who hath been Commissioned Sheriff of this County by a Commission from the Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor with the seal of the Commonwealth annexed bearing date the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 1842. This day appeared in Court and together with Edwards Ruttell William J. Schell Robert Risk Nicholas M. Schell and Clements Rockwell his sureties entered into three several bond in the penalty of \$30,000 each conditioned according to law which bonds were acknowledged by the obligors therein named & ordered to be recorded. And the said William L. Everett took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth the oath against deserting the oath to support the Constitution of the United States and the oath of Office.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Forts bridge this day made their report in the following words to wit "Agreeable to the above order from the aforesaid Court of Southampton we the undersigned have let the repairs of Forts Bridge across the River Crake as above directed and Henry Petway became the undertaker for the sum of nine Dollars, and we do further report that the same is done according to contract. Given under our hands this 24<sup>th</sup> day of December 1842." Benj Applegate Thomas Wrenn".

The Commissioners appointed to let the altering of the Road on the South side of the Nottingay River near Jerusalem this day made the following report to wit "The Commissioners appointed to let and repair the road nearby Jerusalem by Law to report that the road was completed according to the terms agreed upon by the commissioners, and after an examination was duly received which is respectfully submitted to the Court. G A W Neum J H Schell A M Schell W D Goddard Comm Whereupon the Court doth establish the new road as a public highway & order that the old road be discontinued.

On the motion of Septa Darkford against Alfred Risk guardian to John Pettes & Mary Pettes orphans of Joseph Pettes dec'd for County County. This day came the parties in this present person who being heard it is ordered that the said Alfred Risk give the said Septa Darkford good and secure security, the land for which is to be in the penalty of \$30,000 and conditioned as the law directs. Whereupon the said Alfred Risk together with J D Mapendbury Esq: Rockwell & Wm & Petway his securities entered into & acknowledged a bond according to the above order.

The Court doth appoint William Edwards guardian to Louise Vaughan orphan of Anthony Vaughan and therefore the said William Edwards together with William V. Edwards and Orvan Vaughan his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Thousand Five hundred Dollars conditioned according to law.

Frances A Smith orphan of John Smith with the approbation of the Court made choice of Theodore Tugman for her guardian & thereupon the said
