acknowledgment of the wife, admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John McBrady of the first part William R. Boyard of the second
part and Richard A. Dill of the third part, conveying one hundred and five acres of
land acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by John McBrady a party thereto
and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Robert Raiford and wife Mordicai Bradshaw
conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by
Robert Raiford a party thereto and together with the certificate of the surveyor examination
and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Johnson Raiford and wife Charles S. Gold &
William Raiford to Mordicai Bradshaw conveying land was passed in the
Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by the oaths of Benjamin Griffin & Mr.
G. Stevenson & Brodwin G. Griffin the witness thereto is together with the
