

Deed of trust between Lauson Beale of the first part John M Gurley of the second part and Nathaniel Williams of the third part conveying land horses cattle hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by said Beale & Williams two of the parties then present to the end Bill of Sale from William Bryant to Henry Stender conveying his (the said Bryant's) interest in the down negroes of Temperance Dayard widow of Charles Bryant &c^s was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by said Bryant and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Richmond Edwards to Seth B Williams conveying his (said Edwards) interest in the house right of Nancy Edwards both real and personal, also all his interest in the Estate of Elizabeth Williams of all descriptions was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by said Edwards and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Samuel B Bins to William L Corvett high Sheriff conveying two quarters with one half acre of land attached to each was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of January 1843 by said & admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin Cobb of the first part Samuel Stiles of the second part and John M Gurley of the third part conveying land hogs & cattle and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of January 1843 by all the parties then and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Robert S Feltow to William Cobb conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of January 1843 by said Feltow and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Joyner & wife to Seph Blyth conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of January 1843 by James Joyner a party then and together with the Certificate of the prior examination & acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Daniel Fowler of the first part James Holmes of the second part and Carr Bowers of the third part conveying land & negro slaves was proved in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of January 1843 by the oaths of Solomon Lemuel Wilson & Suckow Lawrence two of the witnesses then. And in the Clerk's Office the 19th day of January 1843 this indenture was proved by the oath of William Turner another witness then and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Spratly I Williams of the first part John Waddell of the second part and Britton Baskley & wife of the third part conveying a certain lot in Jerusalem was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th day of January 1843 by said Williams a party then and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Britton Baskley & wife to Spratly I Williams conveying a certain lot lying and being in the Town of Jerusalem was returned in the Clerk's Office the 20th day of January 1843 together with the Certificate then annexed is admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Daniel Fowler of the first part John R Williams of the second part and Abram B Gardner of the third part conveying land negro slaves hogs & cows and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 24th day of January
