Whitehead Charles Walter Williams Carter and all the other creditors of the said Solomon J. Barkham of the third part conveying negro slaves was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 25th day of January 1843 by Barkham Edward Gurley & Mahone four of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of trust between Benjamin Palmer of the first part Clements Rockelle of the second part and James Magee Trustee of the third part conveying land negro slaves horses cattle hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 25th day of January 1843 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas J. Trotter to Thomas Trotter conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 28th day of January 1843 by said J. Trotter and admitted to Record.
- Deed of trust between Arthur O'Hagan of the first part Ernest Carr of the second part and George H. Clegg trustee of the third part conveying a negro slave horse cattle hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 5th day of February 1843 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of bargain and sale from Joseph J. Williams to William J. Williams conveying his (W. J. W.) interest in a certain tract of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 2nd day of February 1843 by said Sir J. Williams & admitted to Record.
- Deed of trust between John W. Run of the first part Mark T. Peale of the second part and Sampson O'Reilly Nathaniel Francis John Drury & Henry Moore all of the third part conveying land negro slaves horses cattle and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 5th day of February 1843 by J. W. Run & Mark T. Peale two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of trust between William A. Williams of the first part Spenalty A. Williams of the second part and Thomas J. Trotter of the third part conveying his (W. A. W.) interest in a certain tract of land (including the interest in the widow Sarah late wife Williams dec'd) and one negro slave was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 5th day of February 1843 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of bargain and sale from John A. B. Bell to Edwards Bullock conveying his (John A. B. B.) interest in Peter Booth estate was proved in the Clerks Office the 7th day of January 1843 by the oath of William A. Bell a witness thereto And in the Clerks Office the 6th day of February 1843 this deed was proved by the oath of Patrick H. Rollings another witness thereto and admitted to Record.
