Wells Henry P. Bixby and Mary Royal the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deal of trust between Hardy Raals of the first part James M. Raals of the second part and Abram Riddick of the third part conveying land one negro slave horse cattle hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 11th day of February 1843 by A. Raals & J. M. Raals two of the parties trustees and admitted to Record.

Deal of trust between Eliza Pope of the first part Delah Ellsworth of the second part and Matthew Vick of the third part conveying his (Pope's) interest in certain negro slaves also horses cattle hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 13th day of February 1843 by all the parties trustees and admitted to Record.

Deal of trust between Joseph C. Ferguson George Gray & Denis Vick conveying to the clerk saddle gun and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of February 1843 by said Ferguson & Gray two of the parties trustees and admitted to Record.
