Holdings of the first part, James Wells of the second part and Edwards Batts of the third part, conveying land and negro slaves was presented in the Clerk's Office the 10th day of February 1843 by the oath of James B. Wellens Henry F. Briggs and Mary Royal the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Hardy Raule of the first part, James M. Raule of the second part and Abram Riddick of the third part, conveying land, negro slaves horses cattle hogs, and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 11th day of February 1843 by H. Raule, J. M. Raule two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Eliza Pope of the first part, Selah Elbworth of the second part and Matthew Vick of the third part, conveying two thirds interest in certain negro slaves also horses cattle hogs and other personal property, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 13th day of February 1843 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Joseph L. Ferguson George Hony & Lewis Vick conveying to the clerk saddle gun and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of February 1843 by said Ferguson & Hony two of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.
