The Commissioners appointed to make sale of the land mentioned in this cause this
 day made the following report. "In compliance with the attached decree directed
 us the undersigned commissioners after having given nearly days notice of the time and
 place of sale met on the premises on the 30th day of November 1842. and exposed to
 public sale the tract of land therein mentioned on a credit of nine months when and
 when William Bryant became the purchaser for the sum of ninety dollars, which we
 have divided as follows to wit we deducted eleven dollars to defray expenses of
 the sale which left a balance of seventy nine dollars, for the one half of which say thirty
 nine dollars and 50^{cts} we took a note payable nine months after date and assigned
 it to William G. Stephenson in his own right, the balance say thirty nine dollars and 50^{cts}
 we divided in the following way. Vigt we took a note for one sixth say six dollars
 50^{cts} payable in nine months and assigned it to Polly Stephenson widow of Henry
 Stephenson in lieu of her dower the balance say thirty two dollars and 90^{cts} we took three
 notes of equal amount payable in nine months say for ten 90^{cts} each which we filed
 in the Clerk's office as by the decree directed all which proceedings we respectfully
