The Commissioners appointed to divide the slaves mentioned in this cause, and make the following report to wit, "In obedience to the within order we have allotted to Virginia Ann infant daughter of Joshua Stone the following negroes Sylvia, Nicholas & Mary Jane, and she to pay to the children of William A Stone dec^d, the sum of fifty dollars, and we have allotted to Sarah A F. Eliza and William infant children of William A Stone the following negroes, Chloe, Felt, Nancy, Henry, Sam, Lydia & Hannah and to receive fifty dollars from Virginia Ann Stone. January 7th 1803. R. Wadley Benj^a Applewhite Thos Ridley"

On motion of Elizabeth Drift. Ordered that she be exempted from the payment of taxes & fees for her slave Nelly in future she being aged and infirm.

This day this cause was docketed by leave of Court and consent of parties and came on to be tried on the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order & adjudge & decree that Nathaniel Mann, James C Selas and Henry Bellows be appointed Commissioners of this Court, that they or any two of them, be authorized to sell out of Gregory Raulings dec^d for sale to satisfy the claim of J & S Drury such negroes as come to be lost or parted from the estate, and that they offer said sale to the highest bidder upon a credit of six months, after determining the time and place of sale for twenty days and pay over the bonds to J & S Drury upon their releasing the trust they hold in the estate, that they divide the remainder of the estate both real & personal into four equal parts and allot one share to William Green in right of his wife, one to William Drantly in right of his wife, one to Samuel Raulings in his own right and the other to William H Raulings in his own right, and that they report therefrom to the Court in order to a final decree. The Court doth further order that the children who have been admitted shall advance a salary for the education of those awarded.
