Margaret Whitfield & Norfolk P. Whitfield under lawful age by Thos Edwards their guardian ad litem and Jacob Barnes son of George Whitfield do. This cause was this day docketed and heard by consent of parties. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Jacob Barnes lessee of George Whitfield do pay over to the complainant Martha Whitfield the sum of \$. And being the amount of his proportion of the balance due her father estate after deducting his proportion of this sum to the legally constituted guardian of Margaret & Norfolk P. Whitfield their proportion each individually after like deduction & that Thomas B. Morell Jacob Barnes & Joshua W. Myrick any two of whom may and be appointed commissioners to divide the real & personal estate of the said George Whitfield into three equal parts, allotting one to the complainant Martha one to Margaret and one to Norfolk P. Whitfield and that the said Barnes & the said Commissioners make report to this Court of their acting and doing as this behalf in order to a final decree.

Upon the application of Robert S. Galloway who is desirous of enjoining against Mill or the Notterway swamp in this County setting forth that he is the owner of the lands on the left side of the Notterway swamp in this County and that Mary White, Charles White & Mrs. Moore are owners of the land on the opposite side of the said River and Giblum Edwards on the last side. And it appearing to the Court that the said Mary White, Charles White & Mrs. Moore & Giblum Edwards have had ten days previous notice of the application they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is ordered that a writ of ad quod damnum be issued to the Sheriff of this County directed to be served
