This cause was this day docketed and heard by consent of parties. On consideration thereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Jacob Barnes executor of George Whitfield d.c. pay over to the complainant Martha Whitfield the sum of \$ that being the amount of her proportion of the balance due her father's estate after deducting her proportion of expenses of this suit to the legally constituted guardian of Margaret & Asst B Whitfield their proportion each individually after like deduction & that Thomas B. Merrill Jacob Barnes & Augustin Pope any two of whom may not be appointed commissioners to divide the real & personal estate of the said George Whitfield into three equal parts, allotting one to the complainant Martha one to Margaret and one to Asst B Whitfield and that the said Barnes & the said Commissioners make report to this Court of their doings and doing in this behalf in order to a final decree.

Upon the application of Robert S. Bellows who is desirous of an entry against Will or the Notterway swamp in this County setting forth that he is the owner of the lands on the last side of the Notterway swamp in this County and that Mary White, Charles White who now are owners of the land on the opposite side of the said swamp and William Edwards on the last side. And it appearing to the Court that the said Mary White, Charles White, John Moore & William Edwards have had ten days previous notice of this application they were solemnly called but came not.
