Stephenson of the second part and Wilborn Stephenson of the third part conveying land, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th day of February 1863, by Joyner & Wilborn Stephenson two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John H. Delphugh to John Boney conveying land, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th day of February 1863 by said Delphugh and admitted.
