Ordered that Henry Council Mathew Vick & William Vick & John Vick to
summoned to the first day of June term next to shew cause why Information should
not be filed against them upon the presentment of the grand jury this day made
against them.

The Last Will and Testament of William Garrison did now proved by the oaths
of Merit I Davis & Leonard Cobb two of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded
and on the Motion of Edwin Garrison one of the Executors therein named who made oath
and together with H. J Smith & Riddish and Etheldred Warren his securities interdicted
and acknowledged a land in the penalty of twenty thousand Dollars conditioned as the law
directs. certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form

Ordered that Etheldred Warren Merit I Davis Leonard Cobb & Hanning T Smith
or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for the purpose do
appraise all the personal estate of William Garrison deceased and return the same under
their hands to the Court.

By consent of parties the license hereupon granted Hiram Bowery to keep an Ordinary
in Tiverton is transferred to George A W Nevers according to Law. It appears
to the Court that the said Nevers is a man of good character & not addicted to
drunkenness a gaming, whereupon the said Nevers gave bond £50

On Motion of Robert S Barnes. Ordered that Merit I Whitney render an account
of his administration on Joshua Whitney's estate before a Commissioner of the Court
and that the said Commissioner examine state & settle the same & make up & have
in Court with any matter specially stated deemed pertinent to himself or which he may be
required to state.

On Motion of John J Pearce. Ordered that John T J Mason who is hereby appointed
Special Commissioner for the purpose do State settle & adjust an account of said
Pearce's administration on Joseph Easton's estate & make report thereof to Court with
any matter specially stated deemed pertinent to himself or which he may be required to do.
