following report to wit: "In obedience to a decree of the honorable Court of Southampton
County February Term 1803. and to us directed as Commissioners we proceeded to sell a
part of the slaves belonging to the Estate of Gregory Baileys decd. as directed in said decree
and paid the proceeds of said sale to Samuel & John Baileys upon their giving a receipt
in full for all claims they held against Shuck Baileys which receipt is hereto annexed as
follows.

Which amount was paid to S. J. Baileys
