Bray & Sally Johnson two of the parties thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife, admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John M. McLeod and wife to James D. Denney, William C. Denney, Mary D. Denney and Francis L. Bates in right of his wife Emma Kate Emma Denney, conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th day of March 1843, by John M. McLeod a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife, admitted to Record.
