

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that Joseph T. File Edwards Beaton and Nathaniel Williams or any two of them do view & report to the Court the propriety of letting out the repairs of the bridge across the Tamara Creek on the road leading from the bridge to Bowakes Bridge & the road near thence, to the Court undated & make report to the Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon the Justices of this County to give Person next to take into consideration the propriety of extending the embankment on the west side of the Notaway River near Jerusalem.

Ordered that George A. M. Newson Fielding J. Malone & William S. Goodwyn or any two of them let to the court undated the repairs of the embankment on the west side of the Notaway River near Jerusalem & make report thereof to Court.

On Motion of Shugars Sain. Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine state & settle an account of the said Shugars Sain transactions as Curator of Catharine Sain and make report thereof to Court with any matter specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to do so state.

The last Will & Testament of William Hale did. now proved by the oaths of Harrison D. Moore & James T. Moore two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of Elizabeth F. Hale the executors thereto named who made oath and gave bond that the will directing no security should be given, and the Court requiring same in the penalty of six thousand Dollars, conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted her for obtaining probate of said Will in due form.

On the Motion of George Mason. Ordered that the unadministered estate of Martha Newson do be committed to the hands of William L. Enright Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

On the Motion of James Clayton against Edward Beaton & Levi Hall. This day came the Plaintiff by his attorney, and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants have had legal notice of this motion. They were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the defendants the sum of thirteen dollars and twenty five cents with interest thereon from the 35th day of December 1843 till paid. It being for a claim placed in the hands of Thomas P. Hale as Constable of Southampton County (for whom the said Defendants were security) to warrant out in favour of the Estate of Benjamin Blunt. And also that the Plaintiff recover against the Defendants his costs by him on this behalf expended. And the said Defendants in discharge
