Pope of the third part conveying horse hays beds &c. and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of April 1843 by Charnel & Pope two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between George Story of the first part William B. Clarke of the second part and Harmon S. Pope of the third part conveying bacon corn fodder horse hays &c. and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of April 1843 by Story & Pope two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Jackson, two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Anthony Woodward of the first part John M. Dealy of the second part and Joseph T. Cloud of the third part conveying said Woodward's entire estate both in the real and personal estate of Samuel Woodward d. d. was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of April 1843 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John M. Teller and wife to Robert R. and wife conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of April 1843 by John M. Teller a party thereto and together with the testimony of the jury examination and oath and return of the jury admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Mary Ann Brooks to James S. Williams conveying her interest in the tract of land formerly belonged to her by Deeds was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of April 1843 by said Mrs. Brooks and admitted to Record.
