Deed of bargain and sale from Dorothy Hollens to William L. Orrick Sheriff conveying her son's interest in the lands when her late husband John Hollens died by will specified was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 25th day of May 1843 by said Hollens and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Joseph B. Ferguson of the first part Anthony McHewell of the second part and Richard B. Ferguson of the third part conveying J. B.
