Nicholson Jesse Parker and Mills M. Lawrence the witnesses thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Allen Edwards to Thomas J. Drister conveying was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 1843 by said Edwards and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Mary Drake of the first part John Edwards of the second part and C. By Drake of the third part conveying lands &c. cattle hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1843 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Harcum to Seth M. Williams conveying Harcum's interest both real and personal in the Estate of Catherine Lawrence d<sup>ce</sup>. was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1843 by said Harcum and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between William Mallory of the first part James E. Peters of the second part and E. James C. Anderson Hairs and Daniel R. Newsum of the third part conveying household and kitchen furniture stock of goods horse cattle and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1843 by Mallory Peters two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin H. Bartle of the first part Edwin Harrison of the second part and Spencer T. Smith and Abram Biddick of the third part conveying land negro slaves horse and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1843 by Bartle Harrison two of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Dorothy Wellens to William L. Cornell Sheriff conveying her dower interest in the lands whereof her late husband John Wellens died seised and deforced was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May 1843 by said Wellens and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Joseph B. Ferguson of the first part Anthony M. Howell of the second part and Richard B. Ferguson of the third part conveying J. B. Ferguson's interest in the lands and appurtenances of his late father Biron Ferguson's Estate was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1843 by A. M. Howell a party thereto and in the Clerk's Office the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1843 this indenture was acknowledged by Joseph B. Ferguson another party thereto and admitted to Record.
