Ordered that Jesse Barker, Seth R. Williams & William Cobb or any two of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the Cypress Swamp bridge, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Oran Vaughan be appointed Surveyor of the Menomonee Road, in the room of Anthony Vaughan deceased & it is ordered that the usual bond be taken thereon.

Ordered that Jesse Drury, James H. Schell, George A. M. Newson, Fielding J. Mahone and William J. Goodwyn or any three of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the ground bridge, one between the lots of J. B. Nicholson & Sally Royal & the other between the lands of Thomas B. Jones & the Estate of James A. Schell, deceased, receive the same when completed and make report.

The Commissioners appointed to view the bridge called Mason's Mill Swamp bridge this day made their report which is ordered to lie on the table, which report is in the following words: "Pursuant to the aforesaid order, we the undersigned Commissioners having viewed the bridge lately built by John B.
