Griffin administrator of Mary Whitfield d. & c. the proportion to which the estate of the said Mary Whitfield is entitled, after making like deduction - That Thomas O'Worrell Jacob Barrett & Alexander Myrick any two of whom may act be appointed commissioners to divide the real and personal estate of the said George Whitfield d. & c. into three equal parts, allotting one to the complainant Martha, one to Margaret and the other to Moslet B Whitfield heir of Mary Whitfield d. & c. and make report to this Court of their acting and doing in this behalf.
