On the Motion of Robert S Patton who is desirous of building a water grist Mill and dam across the Nottoway Swamp in this County and setting forth that he is the owner of the lands on both sides of the said Stream at the place where he wishes to erect the said Mill and dam a writ of ad quod damnum is awarded him to the Sheriff of this County to be directed to be executed according to Law on the 15th day of June next which writ together with the inquest to be taken in pursuance thereof is to be returned to the next Court.
