Deed of bargain and sale from John R. Rockwell to William S. Wilson conveying
land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 15th day of May 1842 by said John R.
Rockwell and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Jacob Bryant of the first part Harmon Soper of the second
part and Mary A. Daughtery of the third part was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the
15th day of May 1843 by Bryant & Soper two of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Solomon Fletcher to Thomas Tellenor conveying land
was proved in the Clerk's Office the 20th day of March 1843 by the oath of Arthur Smith witness
thereto And in the Office the 6th day of May 1843 the said deed was proved by the oath
of Malley S. Daughtery another witness thereto. And in the Office on the 15th day of May 1843
the said deed was proved by Joshua Soper who made oath that he heard Solomon
Fletcher acknowledge the same to be his act and deed, whereupon the said deed was
admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Robert Murrell of the first part James H. Sykes of the second
part and Joseph T. Claud of the third part, conveying the Murrells certain acre of land
with wheel, gun and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office
the 15th day of May 1843 by Claud a party thereto and was proved as to Sykes and the
party thereto by the oath of Wm. D. Sykes and Wm. D. Rice and as to Murrell the other
party thereto by the oath of John M. Gentry Sykes & Prince the witnesses thereto and
admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Johnson and wife to John D. Lovell con-
veying land was proved in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of April 1843 by the oath
of Simeon Parker & H. J. Smith two of the witnesses thereto. And in the Office the 16th day of
May 1843 the said deed was proved by J. James J. Jackson the other witness
thereto & together with the certificate of the proving & examination & acknowledged
