This cause came on to be heard upon the bill answers and exhibits report of commissioners &c and was argued by counsel. Upon a Motion to reverse the proceeding under the said suit, and was heard by consent of parties. Upon consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree, that the lands, sit situated by John and Elizabeth Pope for the purchase of a tract of land, which appears to be devised to them in fee simple under the will of John Pope their deceased father, to the Commissioners under the said decree to wit Nathan Pope, Anthony Mullen & Mills Deft for the tract of land, designated in the said Will "as my land on this side of Craffords road, whereon I now live" be delivered up to the said John and Elizabeth Pope by the said Commissioners in order that the same be cancelled, as having been improperly executed, to the said Commissioners for the purchase of land, sold under the said decree by the said Commissioners, of which the said John & Elizabeth became the purchasers - and if the said lands have been assigned and delivered over by the said Commissioners to any person whatsoever, they are in like manner directed to deliver the same to the said John & Elizabeth Pope and this case is kept open for a further and final decree.

On Motion of Thomas Drake for leave to alter a Road &c The Commissioners before appointed to view the way this day made their report which is ordered to be Recorded which report is in the words following to wit "Agreeable to the above order of Court, on the undersigned have viewed the spring of said road and find it to be a considerable convenience to the public and are incommenure to the public. Given under our hands this 15th day of June 1803. Patrick Rowe, J. Williams, James Holmes" Whereupon it is ordered that the road be altered as proposed, and that Patrick Rowe James Williams & James Holmes be appointed Commissioners for the purpose of reviewing & measuring the said road where opened & put in good repair and to report to the Court.

On Motion of Martha Attkale Ordained that she exempt from the payment of taxes & duties for her slaves, Bess & Moses, Tomp & Abram in future they being aged and infirm.
