This cause came on to be heard upon the bill answers and exhibits report of Commissioners  
of & was argued by Counsel. Upon a Motion to review the proceeding under the said  
suit, and was heard by consent of parties. Upon consideration whereof the Court doth  
adjudge order and direct, that the bonds &c executed by John and Eliza Pope for  
the purchase of a tract of land, which appears to be divided to them in two simple under  
the will of John Pope their deceased father to the Commissioners under the said decree  
to wit Nathan Pope, Anthony Miller & Mills Britt for the tract of land, designated  
in the said will "as my land on the side of Crossroads road, between Innis & the delin-  
der up to the said John and Eliza Pope by the said Commissioners in order that  
the same be cancelled, as having been improperly executed to the said Commissioners  
for the purchase of land, & do under the said decree by the said Commissioners, of which  
the said John & Eliza became the purchasers and if the said lands have been ap-  
signed and delivered over by the said Commissioners to any person whatsoever, they  
are in like manner directed to deliver over the same to the said John & Eliza Pope  
and this case is kept open for a further final decree.

On Motion of Thomas Bratt for leave to alter a Road &c The Commissioners before appointed  
to view the way the day made this report which is ordered to be Recorded, which report is  
on the words following to wit "Agnable to the above order of Court, we the undersigned have  
viewed the opening of said road and find it to be a considerable convenience to the public
