He presented William J. Seabell of the County of Southampton for an assault & Battery upon the body of James D. Mefferting in the Town of Lanesboro' County of Southampton on May Court day last upon the evidence of Harrison Joyner who was sent for by the grand jury and sworn in Court to give evidence, and the grand jury having nothing further to present were discharged.

Ordered that process go out to be served against the persons presented by the grand jury returnable here on August Court day next.

Jeph B Vick is appointed surveyor of the road from Omphers Swamp to Collier's Log house in the name of James Bell &c. & it is ordered that the usual hands work thereon.

Ordered that John Omphers, William Holt, Benjamin B. Waller be summoned to August Court next to show cause why they should not be fined for failing to attend here this day as a grand jury.

Ordered that Joseph F. Bland, William H. Hays, Henry M. Cox, Peter Edwards & Thomas J. Jones do view & report to the Court the condition of the road of which Small Knobs is one of the
