Deed of Release from John Brown & George B. Holleman to Thomas M. Barclay releasing land was acknowledged in the Office on the 15th day of May 1842 by George B. Holleman a party thereto. And in said Deed upon the 12th day of June 1842 the said instrument was acknowledged by John Brown the other party thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Release from Joseph Sutton and George B. Holleman to Thomas M. Barclay releasing land was acknowledged in the Office on the 15th day of May 1842 by Holleman a party thereto. And in said Deed upon the 12th day of June 1842 the said deed was acknowledged by Sutton the other party thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Elizabeth Williams to James Wilson conveying land was presented in the Office on the 17th day of June 1842 by the oath of Patrick River Cruise Turner and Matthew Harrison witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William D. Phillips and wife to William D. Phillips conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 19th day of June 1842 by William D. Phillips a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination was acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edmund Butts, Arthur & Henry John Vock and wife & Anne T. Dunning to William D. Phillips conveying a Water quit Well on the lands attached thereto was acknowledged in the Office on the 19th day of June 1842 by Edmund Butts & Arthur & Henry John Vock witnesses thereto and joined by the oath of Benjamin Griffin, Robert Griffin and William D. Phillips the witnesses thereto as to John Vock & Anne T. Dunning the other parties thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination was acknowledgment of the wife was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James D. Dunning, brother and James Dunning and wife to Mark & James conveying land was presented in the Office on the 25th day of February 1842 by the oath of Edmund T. Turner a witness thereto. And in the Office on the 12th day of June 1842 the said deed was joined to the oath of William D. Phillips and Joseph S. Grant the other witnesses thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Sarah Turner to John D. Barrett conveying her interest in a certain tract of land was presented in the Office on the 19th day of June 1842 by the oath of W. D. Phillips & A. D. Barrett and James Vock the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.
