Matthew Hollings.

The Defendant who is out of the County, and against whom the Plaintiff appears to have proceeded in the mode  
prescribed by law against about Defendant, still failing to appear and answer. On motion of the Plaintiff by his  
Counsel his bill is taken for confessed, and the cause coming on to be heard on the bill, evidence and report of  
William & John Francis & Butts & George Davis Clerk of the Commonwealth, made in the Order of the 15<sup>th</sup> day  
of June 1803, was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, and of appearing from the said report that the  
Defendant has no personal estate in this Commonwealth, and that his real estate to wch a tract of land in  
Southampton County now in the possession of Dorothy Hollings for himself and in remainder to said Defendant.  
Matthew Hollings is worth One hundred Dollars sufficient the life estate of said Dorothy Hollings. The Court doth  
adjudg, rule and decree, that the Defendant a Matthew Hollings pay to the Plaintiff the sum of Twenty eight dollars  
one hundreth and sixteth with interest from the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 1802 till paid over the cost of the suit and one half the  
cost & Matthew Hollings shall pay the same on or before the day of sale. A like bill Edwards is directed to tell & the  
Highway Master the tract of land on which Dorothy Hollings lies, and which belongs in remainder to the said Matthew  
Hollings for each after having advertised the time and place of sale for four weeks, specifically the said date to be  
taken at the Courthouse of Southampton, at either Superior Court, and an advertisement to be posted at the door  
of the Courthouse of the County and at some place near the junction. And the Court doth order that the Commonwealth  
retaining out of the proceeds of the sale the debt, interest, and costs aforesaid, that he make a deed to the purchaser in  
due form & make up his account to the County.

Ordered that Henry McRae, Thomas S. Butts and Samuel Hille being first duly sworn before a Justice  
of the peace for that purpose, appear all the personal estate of Henry Parker do? and return the affidavits  
under their hands to County.

Josie Criffie who stands charged on oath by Martha Sayard a free single woman of this County and
