writ of trust to Parker and the party thereto and is in the Office the 5th day of July 1843 the said Parker was
granted by the Clerk a writ of trust to Parker and the party thereto and is in the Clerk Office the 17th day of July
1843 the said trust was acknowledged by said Parker a party thereto and admitted to Record.

Bill of trust between Horace Hollands of the first part & Wendell Hollands of the second part
conveying slaves of the third part conveying 40 acres of land and slaves was acknowledged in the Office
the 17th day of July 1843 by Horace & Wendell Hollands the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Bill of trust between Miles D. Pease of the first part C. Daight Nash of the second part and Richard
Parker of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Office the 17th day of July 1843 by all
the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Bill of bargain and sale from William Bryant and wife to Horace D. Pease conveying land was
acknowledged in the Clerk Office the 17th day of July 1843 by W. Bryant a party thereto and together with the
writ of the party examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Bill of trust between Thomas W. Newell of the first part James G. Mullins of the second part and
George C. Chappell and others of the third part conveying 40 acres of land and other personal property
was acknowledged in the Clerk Office the 17th day of July 1843 by said Newell Mullins & George
C. Chappell the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Bill of trust between James D. Williams of the first part William S. Morris of the second part and
Almon Reddick of the third part conveying land, slaves and other personal property
was acknowledged in the Clerk Office the 17th day of July 1843 by said Williams & Reddick the parties
thereto and admitted to Record.

Bill of trust between E. Blatchford & Briggs of the first part C. Daight Nash of the second part and
George A. W. Newell of the third part conveying slaves was acknowledged in the Office the 18th day of
July 1843 by Briggs & Nash the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Bill of bargain and sale from Silas Vicks to Horace Pease conveying a certain slave eighty two
and one half pounds other personal property was acknowledged in the Office the 21st day of July 1843 by said
Vicks and admitted to Record.
