A Writting bearing date March 25th 1842 purporting the last Will and Testament of John
Haworth was produced to the Court, and John King was subswearing a copy thereof. William R. Goddard,
Octavia L. Clark being sworn deponed and said that they were well acquainted with the hand writing
of the said John Haworth & verily believe that the body of the said writing as well as the signatures thereto
to be alike in the hand writing of the said John Haworth and the Court having therof satisfied it's selves the
said writing to be made in the last Will & Testament of the said John Haworth Esq. And on the Motion
of George A. Newell the Executor thereon made she made oath and together with John H. Williams his attorney entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Thousand Dollars antecedent
as the law directs to secure a granted him for obtaining a probate of said Will in due form.

Judge of the Superior Court of Probate affix all the personal estate of John Haworth et al. to whom the affix
court made their hands & seals.

the present it appearing that the said Recd a sensible support said slave.

On Motion of Marion A. Morris guardian of Eliza Jane, Nancy & Catharine Bryant espouse of Jonathan
Bryant et al. Ordered that the Plaintiff be allowed to compound of the personalty of his wife's estate twelve dollars
for each of the slaves Eliza Jane, and fifteen dollars each of the girls Nancy & Catharine Bryant for their board
and schooling of this year.
