On the motion of John Mathewson who made oath and together with William Edwards Henry Lefebvre & John Mathewson his executor entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Hundred dollars conditioned with the said court, to appear at a grand jury to be returned at the term of court to be held at the house of the gauger due in due form.

The bond doth oblige James A. Wolfe guardian of Maudie dau of Mary F. Wells infant children of M. & M. Wells and through the said Maudie with Edmund of Conington & James W. Wolfe his executor entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars conditioned with the said court.

On the motion of William Edwards guardian of a bond between Bondman, and for reason appearing to the Court, Ordered that the said William Edwards make satisfaction of the terms of his bond & that Bondman do not to be suffered to satisfy the sum of Five hundred and thirty dollars and six cents and with interest thereon until the 21st day of March 1863, that he do not do so or any of the terms of his bond. William Edwards do not to be suffered to pay and satisfy the sum of Five hundred & thirty dollars and with interest from 1st of March 1863 till paid, being the amount respectively due from the said Maudie to John Vick their former guardian, for commissions & costs, & for the said Maudie to be bound, the said several sums of money have been ascertained by John Vick to William Edwards to satisfy a debt due to said Maudie.

He denied & denies to have sold of the County of Southampton (in the market by roads) for selling articles of foreign growth for making or making up, nor James F. Williams also in the County aforesaid (without license) since the 21st of April last upon the evidence of James Williams of the aforesaid County who was sworn in Court and came voluntarily before the grand jury to give evidence.

We the Grand Jurors Rookings and Nathaniel Jones both of Southampton County (formerly by composition) for making an offering to fight together in further view of the County of Southampton on the 13th day of June upon the evidence of William Vick & James C. Lefebvre of the aforesaid County who were sworn in Court and came voluntarily before the grand jury at their request to give evidence. All having nothing further to present were discharged.

Ordered that the proper process be issued against the persons presented by the grand jury who they returned him to the next quarterly Court.
