Deed of bargain and sale from George M. Bardon wife to William Edwards conveying land was acknowledged in the Office the 15th day of September 1842 by George M. Bardon a party thereto, and together with the certificate of the jury examination & acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between George Young of the first part Richard W. Weymouth of the second part and James B. Weymouth of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Office the 18th day of September 1842 by said Young a party thereto, and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between James Cook of the first part Bartholomew Brown of the second part and John Brown of the third part conveying land, was acknowledged in the Office the 18th day of September 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between William M. Bards of the first part George A. H. Munn of the second part and James B. Weymouth of the third part conveying land & household & other personal property was acknowledged in the Office the 21st day of September 1842 by said Bards & Munn two of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin Whitfield of the first part Frederick M. Bell of the second part & William Whitfield of the third part conveying land house & other personal property was acknowledged in the Office the 29th day of September 1842 by said Whitfield & Bell two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Davis wife to Catherine Davis conveying land was proved in the Office the 30th day of September 1842 by the oath of Benjamin Davis a party thereto, and having been filed proved in the Office on the 27th day of July 1842 by said Catherine another party thereto, and was proved in said Office the 16th day of April 1842 by Robert M. Whitfield the other party thereto, together with the certificate of the jury examination & acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Matthew Harris wife to Cyrus Dillard conveying land was returned in the Office the 2nd day of October 1842, and together with the certificate of the said Harris wife & acknowledgment before two justices of the Peace was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William M. Edwards to William J. & Richard M. Delcott conveying land was acknowledged in the Office the 6th day of October 1842 by said M. Edwards and admitted to Record.

Deed of release from C. Wright Nash Richard Borden to Wm. L. Pope releasing land was proved in the Office the 9th day of October 1842 by the oath of William M. Bards William Brown & Thomas Weymouth the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Wm. L. Pope of the first part C. Wright Nash of the second part & Richard Borden of the third part conveying land and one negro slave was proved in the Office the 9th day of October 1842 by the oath of William M. Bards William Brown & Thomas Weymouth the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John M. Willows and wife to Mary Russell conveying land was returned in the Office the 11th day of October 1842 and together with the certificate thereto and acknowledgment of the said Willows wife before two justices of the Peace is admitted to Record.

The Assessor's current & comprehensive report of Samuel Denny Esq. on the proceedings in regard to the Poor Law having been on hand and no returns having been filed, was considered and ordered to be recorded.
