

after having the parties by their attorneys granted the administration to the said William A Jones then his executor bond with security in the sum of One thousand dollars with good security & acknowledged according to Law. Whereupon the said William A Jones offered to enter into said bond & to take the said Joseph T. Blount & Sampson Blount who security which was deemed sufficient by the Court but before the said bond was entered into, the said Francis & Jones payed no appeal from the opinion of the Court to the next to wit the Superior Court of Law and Chancery for this County which is granted here upon his giving bond with security in the sum of One hundred dollars conditioned according to law which was accordingly done.

The Court doth appoint William A Jones executor of the estate of Elizabeth McLemore dec'd, during the audit about the administration of said estate, whereupon the said Jones together with Joseph T. Blount & Sampson Blount his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

Ordered that Howell Harris of the Nation & others to Thomas & Henry Moore or any three of them being forth duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for the purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Elizabeth McLemore dec'd and return the said appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent moneys in his hands pay to James McSwath the sum of thirty dollars for rebuilding Ruffin bridge.

On Motion of John Hummell. Ordered that John F. J. Mason who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose shall settle & adjust an account of the said Hummell's administration on the estate of Daniel Smith dec'd & make up a bill there to the Court with every matter especially stated & demand put in by himself or which may be required by the Court.

X Daniel H. Draygo a factor of this County reported to the Court that a runaway slave has been committed to the jail within the last two months, whereupon the Court appointed Long McNewson John W. Roberts & William Bourge do view & report to the Court the value of the said runaway, whereupon they appeared in Court & were sworn according to Law.

X For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the overseer of the Poor send Chery Mangum a free negro to Nicholas Bradshaw according to Law without the said Bradshaw paying any thing for the hire of said Chery Mangum.

X For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Overseer of the Poor send Lucy Ann Ricks daughter of James Ricks free negro to Bennett & Griffin according to Law the said Griffin paying to the mother of said Lucy Ann Ricks the sum of Four dollars per year the last of year from now to be paid to the overseer.

Ordered that the Estate of David Rogers dec'd be committed to the hands of William L. Powell Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

X On the Motion of John Carroll Curator for Siles Branch an idiot it is ordered that the said Carroll do to the highest bidder in a credit of nine months a Slave by the name of Cady belonging to said Siles Branch and expend the proceeds in the maintenance of said Siles Branch.
