

after having the party by their attorney granted the administration to the said William A. Jones upon his reciting trust with security in the faculty of one hundred dollars with good security & conditioned according to Law. Wherefore the said William A. Jones offered to enter into said bond Standard Joseph T. Oland & Sampson & Klein as his security which was deemed sufficient by the Court, but before the said bond was entered into, the said Francis A. Jones brought out official from the opinion of the Court to the most virtuous Superior Court of Justice and Chancery for the County which granted him upon his giving bond with security in the faculty of one hundred dollars conditioned according to law which was accordingly done.

The Court doth appoint William A. Jones, master of the estate of Elizabeth McLearn deceased, during the time about the administration of said estate, to whom the said Jones together with Joseph T. Oland & Sampson & Klein his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the faculty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

Ordered that Standard John Martin, Nathan & Thomas & Henry Moore or any two of them being justly sworn before a justice of the peace for the purpose do appear at the personal estate of Elizabeth McLearn deceased and return the said appearance under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County, out of any contingent money in his hands payable to James H. Smith the sum of thirty dollars for rebuilding Buffon bridge.

On Motion of John Kinnicutt, Ordered that John F. Mason who is hereby appointed Special Committee desired for the purpose shall settle of object an account of the said Kinnicutt's administration on the estate of Daniel Wells deceased & make report thereof to the Court with any matter specially stated therein pertaining by himself or which he may be required testifying.

X Daniel H. Draycock factor of this County reported to the Court that a runaway slave has been committed to the jail within the last two months whereupon the Court appointed George A. Wrenson, John H. Rockell & William Barron to view & report to the Court the value of the said runaway, whereupon they appeared in County court were shown according to Law.

X For reasons appearing to the Court, Ordered that the master of the Poor bind Lucy Ann Ricks a Negro girl to Michael Broadhead according to Law, without the said Broadhead paying anything for the hire of said Lucy Ann Ricks the sum of Ten dollars per year. The last year to pay unto the Appraiser.

Ordered that the Estate of David Rogers deceased be committed to the hands of William A. Russell Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

X On the Motion of John Carroll Curator for Edna Branch an idiot who is under the care of the said Carroll set to the highest bidder in a term of nine months a Slave by the name of Lucy belonging to said Edna Branch and subject thereto in the maintenance of said Edna Branch.
