This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly made and was argued by Counsel. On
consideration whereof the Court doth order adjudge and decree, that Harrison both administrators of Amanda
Gilling be authorized to retain out of the amount of sale directed by the former decree so much as may be
necessary to pay the debt of the Estate.

On the Motion of Meredith Holland who made oath and together with Harrison B. Morris and
Matthew M. Vaughan his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred
dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration as the estate
of Victor Ely dec'd in due form

Ordered that Matthew M. Vaughan Hardy Paul Gordon C. Johnson Jacob Saxon or any three of
them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for the purpose. appraise all the personal estate of Victor
Ely dec'd and return said appraisement under their hands to Court

On the Motion of Harrison B. Morris who made oath and together with Meredith Holland & John
W. Rochelle his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars. Con-
ditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on Jonathan Carrs Estate
in due form

Ordered that Meredith Holland. Harrison Faggus. John both William Beale & John B. Southwick or any
three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for the purpose. appraise all the personal estate of Jon-
athan Carr dec'd. and return the appraisement under their hands to Court

The last will and Testament of Herbert Sanier dec'd was proved by the oath of Alfred S. Drittle. Mar-
garet A. Hart & Elizabeth Carroll the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded.

Patrick M. Rollins of the County of Southampton who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance
here to answer the complaint of Thomas Breen against him for a breach of the peace. appeared in discharge
of his recognizance and the said Breen being sworn and examined and the said Rollins fully heard. the Court
after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case. order that the said Complaint be
dismissed and that Thomas Breen the prosecutor pay the cost of this prosecution.

Solomon Johnson of the County of Southampton who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to
answer the complaint of William Beale against him for a breach of the peace. appeared in discharge of his
recognizance. and the said Beale being sworn and examined. and the said Johnson fully heard. it is
ordered that the said Complaint be dismissed and that the said William Beale pay the cost of this prosecution

Ordered that the Account of William A. Corbett Sheriff of this County amounting to seven dollars and fifty
eight cts. be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment
