Postor for his administration on the estate of New Postor de^r and that they conceive themselves in danger of suffering thereby and paying the cost for relief. It is ordered that the said Charles J. Postor be commanded to appear here on the first day of December next to show cause of any he can why he should not be ordered to give the said Joseph Postor and Robert Postor counter security or to execute a new bond with security according to Law.
