The Court certifies that it appears to them from evidence introduced that Abelle B. Sumner was the apprehender of William Jones a free negro who was charged with being a runaway and was afterwards committed to the office by the Court of Accomack County.

Edw. Vick who is in custody of the Sheriff of this County by virtue of two warrants one in the name of Abelle B. White name of James Vick de^d and the other in the name of Seth R. Long 18th was brought into Court and discharged and delivered in a schedule of his stock and made with thanks according to Law. Whereupon it is ordered that the said Vick be discharged from custody of detainer for no other cause than the warrant aforesaid.

David Atwood who is in custody of the Sheriff by virtue of an warrant at the suit of James M. Williams was brought into Court and presented and allowed in a schedule of his stock and made with thanks according to Law. Whereupon it is ordered that the said David Atwood be discharged from custody of detainer for no other cause than the warrant aforesaid.

Ordered that the bench adjourned till 6 o'clock morning next to be held.
