Strong 18th was brought into Court and Subscribed and delivered in a schedule of his estate and made oath thereunto according to Law. Whereupon it is ordered that she be discharged from custody of detainers for as there exists then the warrant aforesaid.

David Ames who is in custody of the Sheriff by virtue of an warrant at the suit of James B. Williamson was brought into Court and Subscribed and delivered in a schedule of his estate and made oath thereunto according to Law. Whereupon it is ordered that she be discharged from custody of detainers from that cause then the warrant aforesaid.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
