Therefore it is ordered by the Court that the Commonwealth recover against the Defendant the sum of one cent the fine specified in the indictment and the costs of this prosecution. And the said Defendant may be taken off.

Whereupon the Court after viewing the valuation of opinion that the said runaway without cost at public auction for a sum sufficient to pay the sum fine and other expenses after being confined in jail twelve months it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County do on the first day of January next and having given legal notice thereof sell at public auction to the highest bidder for cash the said Runaway Slave and report an account of said sale to the Court.
