state & settle and account of said Bannell transactions as Curator of Anna Bannell
and make report thereof to Court with any matters stated deemed pertinent by him
self or which he may be required to state

Ordered that John C. Turner & Nathaniel Francis be added to the persons previously
appointed to appraise the Estate of Samuel B. Woodward deceased & that any three
of the appraisers return the appraisement under their hands to Court

The Court doth assign Robert L. Barnes Guardian to Rebecca Ann & William
Stephenson orphans of Henry Stephenson deceased & thereupon the said Barnes
together with John C. Bralle and Thomas B. Womell his Securities entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred Dollars conditioned as
the Law directs

The Last Will and Testament of Persilla Barnes deceased was proved by the
oaths of Alexander Myrick & Henry B. Blaw two of the witnesses thereto and
ordered to be Recorded: and on the Motion of Jacob Barnes the Executor therein
named who made oath and together with Alexander Myrick and Henry B. Blaw
his Securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Four
thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for
obtaining a probat thereof in due form

Ordered that Alexander Myrick Caleb Cusack Henry B. Blaw and Jacob
Barnes or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace
for that purpose appraise all the personal Estate of Persilla Barnes deceased
and return the appraisement under their hands to Court

held by the said Guardians as joint property into two parcels of equal value
and allot one of them to the plaintiff and one to the Defendant Thomas H.
Applewhite: and how they shall have executed this decree make report in open
Court to a final decree with any matters specially stated which they may deem pertinent or which
either of the parties may require to be so stated
