

(78) On Motion of Jacob Carroll: Ordered that Master Commissioner Briggs examine State & settle and account of said Carroll transactions as Curator of Elana Branch and make report thereof to Court with any matters stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that John C. Turner & Nathaniel Francis be added to the persons hereinbefore appointed to appraise the Estate of Samuel B. Woodard deceased & that any three of the appraisers return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

The Court doth adjn Robert S. Barnes Guardian to Rebecca Ann & William Stephenson orphans of Henry Stephenson deceased & thereupon the said Barnes together with John C. Hale and Thomas B. Morell his Scrivener entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two Thousand Dollars Conditioned as the Law directs

The Last Will and Testament of Priscilla Barnes deceased was proved by the oaths of Alexander Myrick & Henry B. Blow two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded: and on the Motion of Jacob Barnes the Executor therein named who made oath and together with Alexander Myrick and Henry B. Bell his Scrivener entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Four thousand Dollars Conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form

Ordered that Alexander Myrick Caleb Everett Henry B. Bell and Jacob Barnett or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose appraise all the personal Estate of Priscilla Barnes deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court

Appelwhite so as to allot one equal moiety thereof in value to the plaintiff Rebecca J. Appelwhite and the other to the Defd Thomas H. Appelwhite that they in like manner divide the Negro slaves held by themselves Guardian as joint property into two parcels of equal value and allot one of them to the plaintiff and one to the Defendant Thomas H. Appelwhite and how they shall have executed this decree make report in order to a final settlement with any matters specially stated which they may deem pertinent or which either of the parties may require to be so stated
