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This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read, where
the Court with some adjournment ordered that the former decree be set aside as to the
particulars without affecting the sales and that the Comptroller take one hour for
one week past and assign the debt to G. Daugherty in right of his wife in full
and also for the balance two bonds of equal amount and assign credit Thoma
Daugherty in right of his wife & the other to the Treasurer of Wiley Burt and
report to the Court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of Jonathan Burt deceased was
returned and ordered to be Received.

William R. Stephenson appeared in Court and resigned the office of Comptroller
in this County.

By Consent of parties the License heretofore granted James Humphreys to sell
merchandise at his store on this County, till May next is transferred to
Daniel H. Immigle according to law: and it is ordered that the said Immigle
have leave to remove his store to Georgetown.

On Motion of James H. Daugherty who made oath and together with Allen
Stephenson and Alfred S. Stephenson his securities entered into and acknowledged their
bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate
granted him for returning letters of administration on the Estate of Catherine Linn
and in due form.

This Last Will and Testament of David Brown dec'd was proved by the oaths of Jno
Harrison Joseph Rice and Benjamin Ellis the subscribing Witnesses thereto and was
to be Received and Legit. & from one of the Executors Thoma James refusing to take
upon himself the burden of the Executors charge, On the Motion of Henry Moss one
of the Executors Thoma James who made oath and together with William A. Fox and
John I. Buchanan his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty
Twenty thousand dollars Conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for
returning letters of administration on the Estate of David Brown deceased with the will
annexed in due form.

Ordered that James Daugherty John Daugherty James S. Westbrook and John A. Fox
or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose
do appraise all the personal Estate of David Brown dec'd and the appraisement under their
hands to be filed.

On the Motion of John White ordered that Master Comptroller Burt do examine the
books on account of his transactions as Guardian of Mary R. White and report thereon to the
Court with any matters stated correct performed by himself or which he may be required to state.

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
