

John Mc Neall having obtained an attachment against the Estate of Benjamin Bruce who has removed out of the County, doth Constate himself, that the necessary power of law cannot be served upon him and the Constable having made return to him he has attached £1000 eight thousand pounds and four shillings & six pence, the sum of which is due from him after satisfying decedent's execution in his hands before he died, and the sum of £1000 eight thousand pounds and four shillings & six pence, is now due from him after satisfying a sum of £1000 eight thousand pounds and four shillings & six pence, which he is trustee for the benefit of Clements Brachette of the name and character of the deceased Benjamin Bruce. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant not appearing to satisfy the attached effects it is Constatuted by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the sum of Twenty three dollars and fifty four cents pounds to be due and the costs, and it is ordered that the Constable make date of the attached effects according to law and out of the time of such date pay and satisfy this judgment to the plaintiff, and the balance any residue to the defendant and recover an account of such date to Grand Jury. And it is ordered that James Magel be summoned as juror to next Court to determine what amount of any is in his hands belonging to said Benjamin Bruce.
