powers as administrator aforesaid be indicted and committed, and that the said Thomas  
J. Sillito pay the said Joseph & Robert Sillito their costs

On Motion of James E. Peters: Ordered that Master Commissioner Bob Edwards  
state and state an account of his transactions as Guardian of the infant of Henry  
Brownsell and make report thereof to Court with any Masters stated damages sustained  
by himself or which he may be required to state: And it is ordered that the  
Guardian do expend twenty five dollars of the principal of each of his bonds to him  
for their support and education

David Vines were examined and certified to be true, made

Ordered that the County be adjourned till the first day of the next term
