The last Will and Testament of John Harris deceased was proved by the solemn affirmations of Elias Draper and Jeremiah Schoepfoll two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. and in the motion of William Harris the Executor therein named who made oath and together with Matthew Harris and Jacobus Riegel his Executors entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs. certificate is granted here for obtaining a Probate of said will in due form.

Ordered that Benjamin Griffin, William Alberts, Thomas J. Roster and John Campy as any two of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of John Harris dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
