Robert G. Coffen is appointed Surveyor of the road from the forks of the river near Wethersville to River
Rough in the name of John Dick who has removed, and it is ordered that the usual bonds do notwithstanding.

Robert Eddley is appointed Surveyor of the road from Wethersville City road to Wethersville swamp
in the name of Edwin Waller removed, and it is ordered that the bonds of John B. Parker and
the other bonds stand here usually posted thereon after an Accounting paid out in expense.

On the petition of Robert J. Pfeifer for leave to build a water grist mill and dam upon the Wethersville
stream in this County. This day came the said Robert J. Pfeifer by his attorney and Henry White,
Charles Buell, John Moore & Gilliland Edwards and Alfred Risks guardian ad litem to Elizabeth
Pfeifer, the proprietress of the land found by the jury to be liable to damages having been duly summoned
on this day formerly called but came not. Whereupon on consideration of the premises returned by
the Jury and on fully hearing the evidence, and all circumstances being weighed it is ordered that the
said Robert J. Pfeifer have leave to build the said Mill and dam upon his paying the damages
found by the jury to the several parties interested.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
