Robert D. Griffin is appointed surveyor of the road from the forks of the road near Middleboro' to the branch on the road of John Vick who has a warrant, and it is ordered that the same bonds be made thereon.

Robert D. Griffin is appointed surveyor of the road from Middleboro' bridge roads to Middleboro' swamp in the town of Otisville, and it is ordered that the bonds of John D. Parker and the other bonds that have usually worked thereon upon an keeping bond were in effect.

On the petition of Robert S. Foster for leave to build a water grist mill and dam upon the Attorney's swamp in this County. This day came the said Robert S. Foster by his attorney and Henry White, Charles Butts, John Howe & William Edwards and Alfred Bates quondam ad libitum to Elizabeth Foster, the proprietors of the land found by the jury to be liable to damages having been duly summoned upon this day personally called but came not. Wherefore on consideration of the evidence returned by the sheriff and on fully hearing the petitioners and all circumstances being weighed it is ordered that the said Robert S. Foster have leave to build the said Mill and dam upon his paying the damages found by the jury to the several parties entitled thereto.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
