This day this cause was decided by consent of parties and with the assent of the Court came to
be heard upon the bill, answer and exhibits, and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof
the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that James D. Hopkington late Sheriff and as such
administrator with the will annexed of James Howell dec'd pay unto James Howell of age guardian
of James Howell the sum of \$21.00 with interest on \$19.00 the said sum from the 31st day of
December 1842 till paid in full of the balance due on his administration account in said estate.
And the Court doth appoint Thomas Howell Henry Standard, Augustus Pope, Peter Pope and Henry
Singer, any three of whom may act, to lay off fifty acres of land belonging to the estate of James Howell
dec'd and sell the same to the highest bidder on a credit of months except so much as will be
sufficient to pay the costs of these proceedings and take account for \$50. and assign the same to
William Howell or for \$50. and assign the same to John Howell and take a bond for the balance
of said sale and assign the same to James Howell of age, guardian of James Howell, having then
good security to each of said bonds and report to the Court on or before a final decree. And that they
make to the purchaser or purchasers a deed for the said land.

final decree.

that the guardian be allowed to expend of the principal of his wards estate the sum of \$50 each
to defray the expenses of their support for the last year and also the sum of \$50 each for the next
year of said wards this year.

Ordered that Standards, Furbell, Henry Blum, Arthur Vick and Richard J. Standish or any two
of them let to the Court underwriter the repairs of the Express Bridge receive the same when com-
pleted and make report thereof to Court.
