This day this cause came on to be heard on the papers previously read and on material evidence &c. On consideration whereof the Court with adjudge wife and decess that Priggenius Deany late Sheriff and Committee of the estate of Thomas Harrison dec^d pay to John A. Darden the sum of thirty one dollars and fifty five cents with interest from 27th March 1836 till paid in full of last term against Thomas Harrison. The said Deany pay to Thomas Davis the sum of two hundred and fifty one dollars and twenty one cents with like interest in full satisfaction of the same against Thomas Harrison which sums constitute the balance due on last account rendered as administrator of Thomas Harrison. It is further considered that Thomas Davis and John A. Darden pay the costs of this suit in proportion to the sums respectively decreed to them.

This execution is to be satisfied for fifteen dollars paid July 19th 1844.
